



# REEDLEY COLLEGE NURSE ASSISTANT PROGRAM

## IMPORTANT NOTES

- The Reedley College Nurse Assistant Training Program requirements are mandated by the State of California for total theory and clinical hours logged as well a score of 70% or higher for passing each test module.
- It is very important that you attend 100% of the scheduled classes. If you miss the first day of class, you will automatically be dropped and a student from the waitlist will be given the opportunity to take your spot.
- The first eight weeks of class are theory hours that are required before you are allowed to begin your clinical hours on the floor.
- The program consists of approximately 16 modules and you must pass the test for each module with a score of 70% or higher. If you do not pass the test for a module, you will automatically be dropped from the program. Again, this is a State mandated requirement.
- Classes will be held at Palm Village Retirement Community in Reedley. You will be on your Reedley College student e-mail before the semester begins with reporting instructions. Please do not call Palm Village with questions on this program as it is run through Reedley College. Palm Village is only providing the facility for the program courses and floor training.
- You will need to purchase your textbook, workbook and binder and bring these to class on the first day. No other items will need to be purchased until after the start of the program. Information about other required purchases will be given on the first day of class.
- **Note: Palm Village is a professional setting and appropriate attire is required. Shorts, ragged cut-offs, and tank tops are not presentable. Make sure all visible tattoos (if any) are covered. Acrylic nails are prohibited (for sanitary purposes).**
- Register at Admissions and Records as soon as you are able to (clear any holds, probations, pay registration fees, etc.). The rosters will be checked periodically before the semester begins to verify your enrollment. If you are not enrolled, you will be contacted on your status. Failure to register before the semester begins may allow a student on the waitlist to take your spot.
