

# APPLICATION TO ENTER FLIGHT SCIENCE

- 1) Apply to become a Reedley College student [here](#). Students will receive a college ID number and an email log-in within a few days via personal email.
- 2) Apply for and receive an FAA Medical certificate (see *FAA Medical online* document)

- B. Before taking a Flight Lab course, students must:
- a. Meet Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) medical qualifications
  - b. Be able to read, speak, write, and understand the English language
  - c. Provide Transportation Security Administration (TSA) proof of eligibility to receive flight training
  - d. Meet the requirements for and receive an airport ID badge. To receive this ID badge, students must pass a criminal background check and hold a state driver's license
  - e. Provide financial capability to cover flight training costs
  - f. Have access to a reliable vehicle to drive to/from classes at Reedley College and flight labs at the Fresno airport
- C. **Students using VA benefits:** The number of new students using VA benefits that may enter this program is limited each semester. This number may vary by semester and is based on current U.S. Department of Veteran's Affairs policies. Students planning on using VA benefits will be notified if they can enter the Flight Science degree using VA benefits. See the *VA Benefits* online document for more details.
