RESOLUTION NO. 2021.36**

**FIRST AMENDMENT TO RESOLUTION NO. 2021.28 – EXTENDING
VACCINATION COMPLIANCE DEADLINE FOR STUDENTS**

WHEREAS, on August 23, 2021, State Center Community College District Board of Trustees passed Resolution No. 2021.28, requiring all employees, students, contractors, and visitors, be fully vaccinated against COVID-19 as a condition to physically accessing any District building, classroom, library, gymnasium, facility, or other indoor space, subject to legally required exemptions for sincerely held religious beliefs and medical conditions; and

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 2021.28's vaccine requirement is scheduled to become effective on October 15, 2021; and

WHEREAS, SCCCCD staff have been implementing the COVID-19 vaccination requirement and in doing so have identified potential challenges for students who were enrolled in SCCCCD programs at the time the vaccination requirement was issued, but who are not yet fully vaccinated or do not yet have an approved medical or religious exemption; and

WHEREAS, SCCCCD Board of Trustees and staff desire to lessen potential challenges for students presented by the COVID-19 vaccination requirement.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the compliance date for the District's vaccination requirement for students is extended until _____, 2021. As a result, all students must be fully vaccinated by _____, 2021, as a condition to physically accessing any District building, classroom, library, gymnasium, facility, or other indoor space, subject to legally required exemptions for sincerely held religious beliefs and medical conditions; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that student-athletes and coaches from visiting colleges and officials (e.g. referees) for athletic competitions may compete and officiate in District facilities as long as visiting student-athletes and coaches and officials adhere to all applicable CCCAA COVID-19 mitigation protocols; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that spectators attending athletic, academic, or art events must show proof of being fully vaccinated or a negative COVID-19 test with a specimen taken no more than 72 hours before entry into District facilities; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that a person wearing a face covering regardless of vaccination status may temporarily enter District facilities for up to 15 minutes to use restroom facilities, drop off or pick up items or equipment, or food from the pantry; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that all other terms and conditions of Resolution No. 2021.28 remain unchanged and in full force and effect.
