Dear President Hioco:

The Accrediting Commission for Community and Junior Colleges, Western Association of Schools and Colleges, at its meeting on January 10-12, 2007, reviewed the Progress Report submitted by the college and the report of the evaluation team which visited on Tuesday, October 31, 2006. The Commission took action to accept the report, with a requirement that the college complete a Progress Report.

The Commission asks that a Progress Report be submitted by **March 15, 2007**. The Progress Report should focus on the institution's resolution of the recommendations and concerns as noted below:

**Recommendation 5: Library and Learning Resources.** The team recommends that the college fully implement the previous team's recommendation by ensuring that professionally qualified library and learning resource staff provide support at all locations where these services are offered currently and will be needed as future centers and campuses are developed. (Standards II.C.1.a, II.C.1.b, II.C.1.c, II.C.2)

I have previously sent you a copy of the evaluation team report. Additional copies may now be duplicated. The Commission requires that you give the report and this letter appropriate dissemination to your college staff and to those who were signatories of your college report. This group should include campus leadership and the Board of Trustees. The Commission also requires that all reports be made available to students and the public. Placing copies in the college library can accomplish this. The Progress Report will become part of the accreditation history of the college and should be used in preparing for the next comprehensive evaluation.
