


Survey was collected during the time-frame of 8/30/2017-9/6/2017 with a result of 734 student responses.

Q1 Which campus do you take majority of your classes?





Q2 What type of program are you enrolled in?





Q3 Have you had to purchase a text ook for any of your courses?





Q4 What is the average num er of ooks have you had to purchase either this semester or previous semesters?





Q5 Where you a le to afford all of your ooks needed within the first 3 weeks of class?





Q6 Have you ever dropped a course ecause you could not afford to purchase the text ook(s)?




