Additional requirements for an Associate of Arts or Science degree include:

Sixty (60) units with at least a 2.0 grade point average in all courses applicable to the associate degree.

Residence requirements:

- A) A minimum of twelve (12) degree applicable units satisfactorily completed in residence at district colleges or centers with attendance during the last semester prior to graduation, or
- B) A total of forty-five (45) degree applicable units satisfactorily completed in residence at district colleges or centers if not in attendance during the last semester prior to graduation.

At least eighteen (18) units in a single discipline or related disciplines (major) or in an approved area of emphasis. Each course applied to the major requirement must be completed with a grade "C" or better, or a "P."
