- Certificate of Achievement in CSU GE Breadth

The certificate of achievement in CSU GE provides students with an introduction to the breadth and depth of liberal arts and science with an emphasis in global perspectives. It provides students with a foundation in the liberal arts and sciences and prepares them for specialized study in a particular discipline or program. CSU Certification is not automatic, please request certification through Admission and Records. This Certificate of Achievement will allow the student to complete the lower division general education required courses but does not meet all the requirements for transfer (see Note). A course or sequence of courses used to satisfy a requirement in one area may not be used to satisfy a requirement in another area. Students should check with a counselor and review the Reedley College catalog for further clarification. Note: The CSU Certificate of Achievement only confirms completing CSU general education requirements and does not meet Associate Degree or transfer admission requirements. CSU transfer admission requirements include the completion of 60 transferable units with a 2.0 or better GPA and 30 units of general education courses with "C" or better grades, including speech (A1), English composition (A2), critical thinking (A3), and mathematics (B4). It is not recommended for students with the following majors to complete this pattern: Engineering and Liberal Studies.
